Qualification of New Computers



- The qualification of new computers at Pole is a subset of the USAP Information Security Policy that is currently under development by NSF and RPSC
- Minimum hardware and software (operating system, security patches, antivirus) requirements will be published on the www.usap.gov website when they become available
- These requirements will be applied to ALL incoming computers (RPSC, NSF, Grantees, etc)

 - an announcement during Orientation offering to scan
 PCs for viruses
 - Spot check computers as time allows



Qualification of New Computers



- Reality of the summer season at Pole
 - South Pole IT O&M will provide as much assistance as possible
 - would prefer to not touch a Grantee computer unless absolutely necessary
 - cannot install commercial antivirus software on non-NSF machines due to licensing. Perhaps a good freeware package is available (e.g., AVG (www.grisoft.com))
 - we must trust that a computer's owner has taken adequate precautions
